TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE MATCHING

OVERVIEW

As a member of the EngageDEI cohort, participating organizations will be matched with a Technical Assistance (TA) provider who specializes in DEI practices. Organizations will have access to the Catalyst:Ed DEI Expert Hub community in order to select a TA provider that is best positioned to support you on actualizing your two-year DEI strategic plans identified via your EngageDEI surveys, goal-setting and support calls.

PROCESS

Participating organizations in EngageDEI will receive guidance and support on developing and articulating a clear project scope through assistance provided by the Catalyst:Ed (CE) team as part of their Matching Process.

CE will help organizations with:

- identifying qualified providers through the DEI Expert Hub;
- reviewing TA provider materials and interviewing them before you make the final decision.

Projects and TA providers will be appropriately matched according to breadth of scope and the expertise required to support implementation. All participating organizations will be funded via the "TA Wallet" made available to all participating organizations to compensate providers. Organizations will have a budgetary range to help identify appropriate project scales.

We anticipate matching technical assistance providers with organizations between July and October 2019. All Technical Assistance projects must be completed by Mar 2021.
